THE HELPLINE ~ A BABY'S LIFELINE

One Saturday afternoon, a young woman named "Helen" (*not her real name*), found us on our website and called our Helpline. Helen was crying and said she needed to talk with someone. She was very upset over a positive home pregnancy test she had taken that morning and didn't know what to do. She described the complicated circumstances in her life and feared judgment, condemnation and disappointment from her family and friends about this pregnancy.

Helen admitted she was a Christian and had always been against abortion but never thought she would be in this situation. She was convinced abortion was her only solution. For the next hour, we talked about her family, her faith in God, the hope of the Gospel, life in the womb, and the truth about abortion. By the end of our conversation, we invited her to come to the Center on Monday morning to talk in person. She agreed.

When we met, Helen shared that she had repented and changed her mind — she was going to keep her baby! *Praise the Lord!* She knew her baby was created in God's image, that God is faithful and would help her with the complexities in her life and with her baby. By the end of the meeting, Helen enrolled in our parenting program. What a blessing it is to walk through this pregnancy and parenting journey with her!

Helen's growing baby is the fruit of one phone call.

The Helpline was her baby's lifeline.

Clients like Helen are why we have a 24-hour Helpline. Sometimes girls contact us in the middle of the night—scared. Others, like Helen, reach out when they are home on weekends or at night after work. And sometimes, men reach out when their girlfriends are too scared to call.

We thank the Lord for the 24-hour Helpline and for being His instrument that providentially lead Helen to choose life for her precious baby. To God be all the glory!

Thank you so much for your prayers and support that makes this ministry possible! And thank you for faithfully standing with us *for life*.

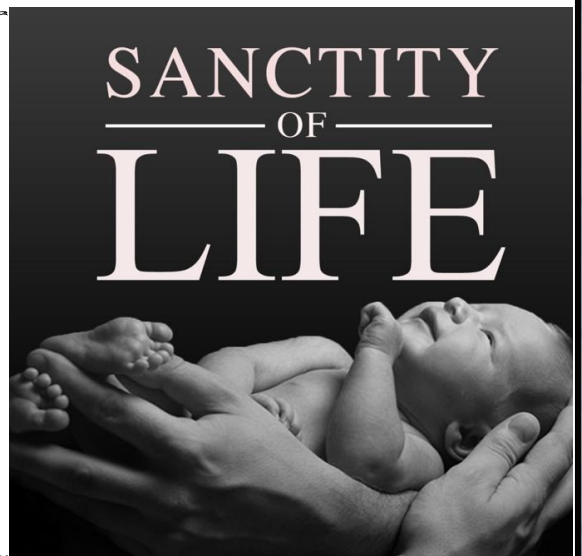
2023: Year in Review
