On January 28, 1985, Crossroads Pregnancy Center, as the ministry is now known, opened its doors to serve our neighbors in Kings County. In 1983, the Lord brought together our steering committee that labored together in prayer, planning, and executing that plan in preparation for opening. We had a vision and burden for starting a ministry that would "stand in the gap" to help end the taking of human life in the womb by ministering to those considering abortion. By providing help in the name of Christ, through loving truthful counsel, compassion, and support to each woman and her unborn child, it was our desire to provide a place of refuge in their crisis.

Crossroads became that place of refuge forty years ago and continues to be that shelter. Our staff, advocates, and volunteers at every "station" of care and responsibility, are faithful servants who give day in and day out with passion to those who seek our help. They are faithfully supported by a dedicated prayer team who "battle in the heavenlies" where the war is waged. We have been and continue to be financially supported by individuals and churches, without which we could not carry out the work of the ministry. The Lord has prompted their hearts to give sacrificially to keep our doors open.

This is a battle that all believers in our Creator God and His Son are called to. If you want to be blessed and you have not already, join us in this battle with a joyful heart and the "armor" our Lord provides. It is a priority battlefront in our times that brings the glorious good news of the Gospel as Jesus did to the Samaritan woman at the well, to the children the disciples tried to shun from coming to Christ, and to those John the Baptist preached repentance to for the forgiveness of sin, turning "the hearts of fathers to the children, the disobedient to the wisdom of the just, to make ready for the Lord a people prepared." Client Advocate Training
