

From the Heart of the Director

One heart at a time...one life at a time



"For he who finds Me finds life and obtains favor from the LORD. But he who sins against Me injures himself; All those who hate Me love death." (Prov. 8:35-36)

We have recently witnessed the fulfillment of Prov. 8:35-36 in the lives and deaths of Iryna Zarutska and Charlie Kirk.

Iryna's cold-blooded murder in Charlotte, NC, captured on video, was made more grievous by the apathy of bystanders who stood by and did nothing, particularly a woman who sat across the aisle, witnessed the attack, turned her back and got off the train at the next stop.

Charlie's horrific assassination, also captured on video, was witnessed by thousands of students on a college campus in Utah—and went viral. Reactions ranged from shock, bewilderment, anger and grief --- and sadly—celebration.

But how is it possible that one man's death is celebrated, and one woman's dying alone could create such a contrast in response?

"They have closed their unfeeling heart, with their mouth they speak proudly. (Ps. 17:10)

Similarly, isn't this what we see with abortion today? A culture of apathy and celebration of the death of the unborn, "giving hearty approval to those who practice them [evil acts] (Rom 1:32). Scripture reminds us that out of the heart come evil thoughts, murder, ..." (Matt. 15:19) because "the heart is more deceitful than all else and is desperately sick;..." (Jer. 17:9)

When a society devalues human life in the womb by slaughtering over one million babies every year, we have become a society bearing the rippling effects of hating God and loving death. However, in the midst of this present darkness "light shall shine out of darkness." (2 Cor. 4:6)

Crossroads Pregnancy Center has been a beacon of light celebrating and upholding the sanctity of human life for 40 years. Every human being, from conception, is created in the image of God. Every child is a blessing and precious gift from God, who was intricately knitted together—fearfully and wonderfully made in their mother's womb -- and intimately known by God. "Before I formed you in the womb, I knew you." (Jer. 1:6); "Your eyes have seen my unformed substance." (Ps. 139:16)

"Rescue those who are taken away to death; hold back those who are stumbling to the slaughter..." (Prov. 24:11)

We understand that to build anything that lasts must have a solid foundation—and the Center's foundation is rooted in the gospel of Jesus Christ, our chief Cornerstone. Just as great structures like the Eiffel Tower, the Colosseum or the Great Wall of China were built over time with strong foundations; likewise, our efforts to build a culture of life are anchored in the love of God, love and compassion for our neighbor, persevering faith, steadfast hope, unwavering truth and persistent prayer in order to rescue the most vulnerable and defenseless among us from the death chambers of abortion and standing firm in the Gospel.

It also means counting the cost of following Christ knowing that we will be rejected, reviled and hated, but we persevere for the glory of God. Jesus reminds us "If the world hates you, know that it has hated Me before it hated you. (John 15:18), but He also encourages us, "These things I have spoken to you, so that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation but take courage; I have overcome the world." (John 16:33)

Our mission is simple: To share the love of Christ in word and deed – trusting God, rescuing life and pointing others to the One who is "the way, the truth and the **LIFE**."

We hope to see you on Saturday, October 18! I know I say this often, but it bears repeating: we are grateful for you, your prayers and support. Your role is vital to the work of the ministry and a blessing to us.

May God continue to build a culture of life through all of us — one heart at a time...one life at a time.


