DONOR PRIVACY: PROTECTED OR NOT?

On December 2, 2025, the Supreme Court of the United States heard oral arguments in **First Choice Women's Resource Center v. Davenport**. On April 29, 2026, the High Court issued its Opinion — a unanimous 9–0 decision in favor of First Choice. This landmark ruling is a monumental victory for our First Amendment freedoms. The Supreme Court affirmed that nonprofit organizations have the right to protect the privacy of their donors and the freedom to challenge the constitutionality of a state subpoena in federal court before being forced to disclose sensitive information.

Summary: “In 2022, New Jersey’s Attorney General established a ‘Reproductive Rights Strike Force’ that issued a consumer alert accusing groups like First Choice of seeking to prevent people from accessing reproductive health care by providing false or misleading abortion information. The Attorney General served a subpoena on First Choice, commanding the group to produce 28 categories of documents, including documents reflecting the names, phone numbers, addresses, and places of employment of all individuals who had made donations to First Choice by any means other than through one specific webpage. Effectively, that demand required First Choice to provide personal information about donors who gave through two other websites, through the group’s various social media pages, by mail, in person, or by any other means. The subpoena warned twice that failure to comply may render the group liable for contempt of court and other penalties. First Choice filed suit in federal district court... seeking to prevent the Attorney General from enforcing the document demands and arguing that the demand for donor information violated its First Amendment rights. First Choice alleged that its inability to guarantee its donors’ anonymity in the face of the Attorney General’s demands injured the group by discouraging donors from associating with it.” *First Choice Women's Resource Centers, Inc. v. Davenport, Attorney General of New Jersey, No. 24-781, slip op. at 1 (U.S. April 29, 2026)*.

Ruling: Justice Gorsuch concluded his opinion: “Since the 1950s, this Court has confronted one official demand after another like the Attorney General’s. Over and again, we have held those demands burden the exercise of First Amendment rights. Disputing none of these precedents but seeking ways around them, the Attorney General has offered a variety of arguments. Some are old, some are new, but none succeeds. Accordingly, the judgment of the Third Circuit is reversed, and the case is remanded for further proceedings consistent with this opinion. It is so ordered.” *First Choice Women's Resource Centers, Inc. v. Davenport, Attorney General of New Jersey, 608 U. S. 22 (2026)*.

We thank the Lord for this ruling because it upholds righteousness as it protects charitable, nonprofit organizations from government overreach, burdensome tactics, and intimidation to silence organizations like ours that stand for the sanctity of life and beliefs not favored by those in power. The Court’s decision strengthens essential constitutional protections for nonprofit organizations nationwide by affirming that the government cannot compel groups to disclose their donors. It also upholds the right of nonprofits to seek federal protection when states impose unconstitutional demands.

For First Choice — and for all of us who value freedom to support their communities without fear of government coercion — this ruling is a profound affirmation of the liberties guaranteed by our Constitution.
