The Rock of Our Refuge

Within five months of the overturning of *Roe vs. Wade*, we witnessed swift efforts by legislators and organizations to make an "individual's fundamental right to choose" abortion and contraceptives enshrined in the California Constitution, and sadly, on November 8, a 65% majority of California voters approved its inclusion.

While it's disheartening that abortion is codified into California's Constitution, it is helpful to remember that it will NEVER be codified in the High Court of Heaven. Consider the Psalmist's urgent warning:

*Can wicked rulers be allied with You, those who frame injustice by statute?
They band together against the life of the righteous and condemn the innocent to death.
But the LORD has become my stronghold, and my God the rock of my refuge.
He will bring back on them their iniquity and wipe them out for their wickedness;
the LORD our God will wipe them out.*

Psalm 94:20-23

C.H. Spurgeon succinctly said of these verses, in part, "God enters into no alliance with unjust authority, He gives no sanction to unrighteous legislation... They legalize robbery and violence, and then plead that it is the law of the land; and so indeed it may be, but it is a wickedness for all that. With great care men prepare enactments intended to put down all protests, so as to render wrongdoing a permanent institution, but one element is necessary to true conservatism, viz., righteousness; and lacking that, all their arrangements of the holders of power must come to an end, and all their decrees must in process of time be wiped out of the statute book. Nothing can last forever but impartial right. **No injustice can be permanent, for God will not set his seal upon it, nor have any fellowship with it, and therefore down it must come, and happy shall be the day which sees it fall.**"

We have seen fifty years of the unsung faithfulness and obedience of Christians in the trenches in the fight for life. And after fifty years, we witnessed the downfall of *Roe v. Wade*.

As we live under this new law of the land, our Righteous and Just God will see to it that this is temporary. Our confidence and hope do not rest in the government, its statutes, laws or decrees.

Our confidence and hope rests in the LORD God, our stronghold and the rock of our refuge.

Our mandate has not changed. We will continue with God's help to "rescue those who are being taken away to death; and hold back those who are stumbling to the slaughter." (Pro 24:11)

Thank you for your ongoing support and prayers for this ministry. We "do not cease giving thanks for you, while making mention of you in our prayers." (Eph. 1:16)

We couldn't do this without you.

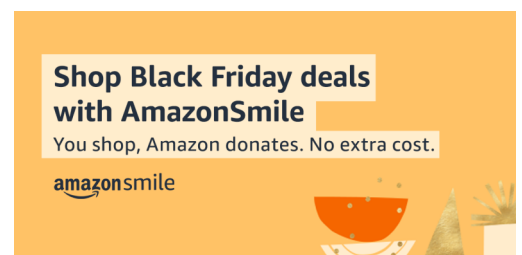
