“Let not your heart be troubled, you believe in God, believe also in Me.” John 14:1

As the war between life and death rages on, the chasm between the two is greatly increasing.

On the LIFE side of the chasm, we are grateful for the movie *Unplanned* revealing truth about abortion and the tremendous impact it has made on the abortion industry. We applaud the eight governors of FL, GA, MS, MO, OH, TN, LA, and TX who signed Heartbeat Bills which prohibit the abortion of babies with a detectable heartbeat. This is certainly cause for rejoicing! Could the tide be finally turning?

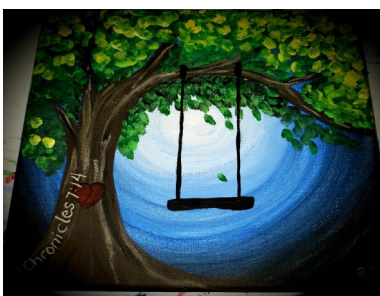


Enid’s Paint Party Benefit for CPC
