

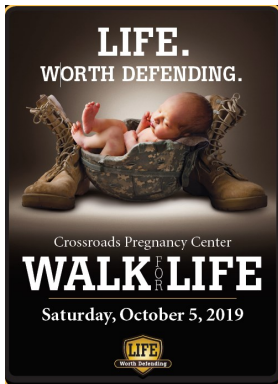

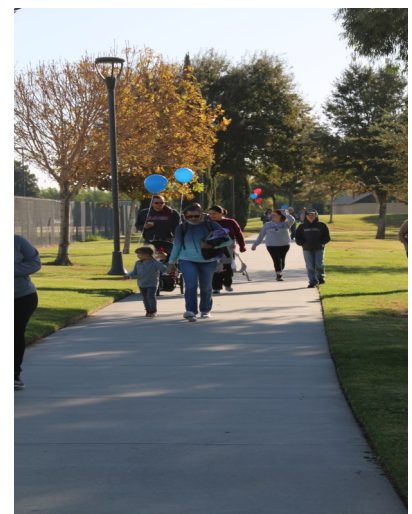
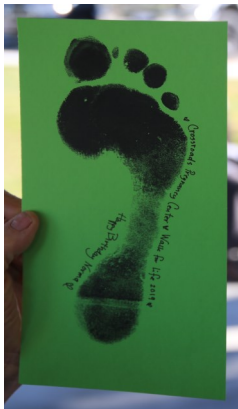

What a Difference a Day Makes!

Julie (not her real name) came in to see us one morning. Distraught and overwhelmed about the possibility of being pregnant, Julie shared with us the challenging difficulties she was facing, yet conveyed a deep desire and longing for her baby. She was convinced that now was not the right time to be pregnant. Homelessness, unemployment, and relationship issues were not ideal circumstances to welcome a baby into the world. She believed abortion was her only option. As we listened, we recognized there was a deep longing in her heart to connect with her parents. It became obvious she loved her Mom and Dad and she knew they loved her. We encouraged Julie to talk with her parents and offered help to facilitate that conversation. An ultrasound was offered to her and an appointment was scheduled that afternoon. We prayed with her and reminded her of God’s love and purpose for her, her family and baby, and that He could be trusted in all things. When she left us, she was hopeful, but remained unsure of her decision.

The next morning, Julie surprised us by arriving at the Center when we opened. We instantly noticed her countenance was remarkably different from the previous morning. She wanted to talk and was smiling from ear to ear. She began to pour out how she had that conversation with her Mom. Although her Mom was surprised by the news of her pregnancy, she assured Julie that everything would be okay. Abortion was no longer an option. Relief, thanksgiving and joy radiated from Julie as she continued to share all that had transpired the past 24 hours!
